Yours they were, and you gave them to me, and they have kept your word. ⁷ Now they know that everything that you have given me is from you. ⁸ For I have given them the words that you gave me, and they have received them and have come to know in truth that I came from you; and they have believed that you sent me. ⁹ I am praying for them. I am not praying for the world but for those whom you have given me, for they are yours. ¹⁰ All mine are yours, and yours are mine, and I am glorified in them.

Introduction

- Jesus is continuing in His prayer for Himself, His disciples, and those who will come later
 - It is a very simple thing we see here in these next few verses
 - As He begins to pray for His disciples...
 - We see 8 things this morning... and they are divided up in two ways...
- > 1) What Jesus Has Done For His Followers
- > 2) Followers Response to Jesus

1) Jesus Has Revealed the Name of God to His Followers

- I have manifested your name to the people whom you gave me out of the world.
- > The Name of God is extremely important to God...
 - The importance of a name.... A name describes who that person is...
 - In those days names meant something... they didn't just sound cool...
 - If a name did not fit someone, we would see God change it...
 - Abram is changed to Abraham
 - Jacob is changed to Israel...

The Name or Names of God Describe and Explain who He is...

- Modern science is doing its best to discover God...
- To discover the nature of whatever it was that started life on this planet
- They are consumed with this project...
- BUT:
 - Jesus has come and revealed.... Manifested the name of God to us...
 - And what a privilege it is to be able to hear from the Son of God
 - Who God is...

When Moses went to the Israelites to deliver them

- He asked God... who shall I say Has sent me....
- God says tell them... I AM that I AM has sent you

- The great I AM
- I exist.... I am existence... Yahweh

When Jesus came to this Earth...

- He was preceded with the name Emmanuel...
- Which means God With Us...

> Jesus is Named Jesus

■ Which means Savior...

> In Isaiah He prophecies the coming of the Messiah

Isaiah 9:6 ⁶ For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

> Jesus Life, teachings, miracles and Character have revealed the name of God to us all....

- Bread and Fish... provider
- Light
- Water
- Healed Lame man
- Blind Man
- Walked on Water
- Patient with His disciples
- Led them and Taught them
- Was merciful and compassionate
 - One of the greatest pictures of who God is, is seen with the woman caught in adultery
 - He says... go... and sin no more...
 - Man... that makes me tremble with thanksgiving...
- The cross He bore without complaint... but with Joy...
- If you want to know God.... Look to Jesus...

2) Followers Belong to God

- Yours they were, and you gave them to me,
- ¹⁰ All mine are yours, and yours are mine,

He has ownership over His people...

- The Son has been Given all that the Father has...
- Those that come to Jesus have been given to Him from the Father...

> Great to see that God has us in His hands... that we are precious and important to Him

- John 10:27-30 ²⁷ My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me. ²⁸ I give them eternal life, and they will never perish, and no one will snatch them out of my hand. ²⁹ My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all, and no one is able to snatch them out of the Father's hand. ³⁰ I and the Father are one."

❖ 3) Followers Keep His Word

and they have kept your word.

> Kept:

■ To hold on to... to guard to protect...

The followers of Jesus love His word, and protect it...

- They hold on to it when times are difficult...
- They do not want His word twisted or turned in the wrong way...

> For the disciples:

- When Jesus gave them the words of God...
- They believed them and held on to them...

> How do we keep His word...

- By reading and studying it...
- By believing it...
- By committing it to memory
- By keeping it pure...
- By not twisting it
- By living it out
- By making it important in our lives...

How have you done in keeping the words of God?

4) Followers Know the Source of Jesus is the Father

Now they know that everything that you have given me is from you.

> They knew Jesus was Given all things from the Father...

This may not seem important but it really is...

> Think of the shock of meeting a man with claims to be from God... to be God himself...

- It may take a little convincing to believe this right...
- I mean... it is strange... it is not everyday that you walk by and meet God on the street in a human body
- This took great Faith... it took great belief

The Disciples were confident and they knew....

- That all His power
- And all His words
- And All his character
- Had come from the Father...

And I believe we also see that they knew Him to be God....

■ John 6:67-69 ⁶⁷ So Jesus said to the Twelve, "Do you want to go away as well?" ⁶⁸ Simon Peter answered him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life, ⁶⁹ and we have believed, and have come to know, that you are the Holy One of God."

How about You

- What do you know about Jesus... Do you see Him as having all things from the Father
- Do vou see Him as God....
- His followers do...

More importantly...

What are you doing with your belief...

- Is it just head knowledge that has been placed in your brain from years of hearing this...
- Or is it truth to you.... Is it how you live your life...
- Is it how you make your decisions
- Do you live out this truth daily

5) Jesus Has Given His Followers the Words of God

- 8 For I have given them the words that you gave me,
- We have already looked at this... But it comes up again here...
 - Just not the grace that we have received to be given the words of God...
 - He has given them to us...
- > We did not pay for them...
 - We did not seek them out...
 - They were given to us freely...
- Jesus came and gave us the words of God...
- > And this continues even until this day.... His followers are giving His words out to those who will hear
- How well do you give out what has been given to you...
 - Do you give the words of God that you have been given
 - If not... why are you keeping them to yourself
- > We should mimic Christ in our Giving of His word...

❖ 6) His Followers Receive, Know and Believe

- and they have received them and have come to know in truth that I came from you; and they have believed that you sent me.
- > Received them... His words
 - Caught them... Grabbed hold of or seized them...
 - Just like center fielder goes after a fly ball...
 - ¹² But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God,
 - 1) Jesus Give us The Right to Become Children of God
 - ♦ Look at the second half of this verse first....
 - Some people will be given the right to be children of God
 - ♦ For this to make sense...
 - ♦ And impact you this morning you must understand...
 - A Foundational Premise From our birth we are born with a fallen nature
 - Bible Describe us as:
 - Brought forth in iniquity, and conceived in sin (Ps 51)
 - Enemies of God (Rom 5)
 - Sons of disobedience (Eph 2.2)
 - Dead in trespasses and sins (Eph 2.5)
 - Paul quoting the Pslams No one is righteous, no one does good...
- Know in truth that I came from you...
 - Know... To understand or perceive...
 - It actually says they have COME to know...
 - I like this... I like how it shows a progression for the Follower of Jesus...

- They may not have know to begin with...
- But after being presented the truth... the facts... they come to know who Jesus is...

> Believe that you sent me

- Believe trust
- They trust that Jesus has come from the Father...
- Remember what Jesus said to the crowd when the wanted to know what they could do to be doing the works of God
- John 6:28-29 ²⁸ Then they said to him, "What must we do, to be doing the works of God?" ²⁹ Jesus answered them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in him whom he has sent."

> His followers have these characteristics...

- They receive
- They know
- They believe

7) Jesus Prays for His Followers

• ⁹I am praying for them. I am not praying for the world but for those whom you have given me, for they are yours.

➤ He does not Pray for the world...

- What a powerful condemnation against those who are opposed to God...
- Against those who will not believe and will be at odds with God
- To those who will remain in rebellion against God
- Through Unbelief...
 - There are hundreds of ways to rebel and sin against God...
 - But unbelief is at the center of it all...
 - A person can be great in the eyes of those around them,
 - but the sin of unbelief will damn their soul to eternal torment in hell
- Jesus is saying... I am praying for my followers that you have given me...
 - I loved the world and came to die so that those in the world may live
 - And there will be many that will come out of the world
 - 1 Peter 2:9 ""called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.
 - Acts 26:18 "to open their eyes, so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the
 power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who
 are sanctified by faith in me."
- Yet He does not pray for those that remain in the world...

➤ He prays for his followers: This is so wonderful!

- Ever lives to make intercession for us
 - Hebrews 7:25 ²⁵ Consequently, he is able to save to the uttermost those who draw near to God through him, since he always lives to make intercession for them.
- If God be for us who can be against us?
- Romans 8:31-39 ³¹ What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? ³² He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things? ³³ Who shall bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. ³⁴ Who is to condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died—more than that, who was

raised—who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us. ³⁵ Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword? ³⁶ As it is written, "For your sake we are being killed all the day long; we are regarded as sheep to be slaughtered." ³⁷ No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. ³⁸ For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, ³⁹ nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

❖ 8) His Followers Glorify Jesus

- and I am glorified in them.
- > Jesus is glorified in them because:
 - They will make His name known to the nations...
 - They will declare the beauty of the Lord to the peoples of the world
- > They Have Kept His Word
- > They know the source of Jesus is the Father
- > They have Received His Word
- > They have come to know he came from the Father
- > They believe He was sent by God
- > Are You enhancing the Reputation of God...
 - With how you live
 - At home with your kids
 - With your spouse
 - You family
 - Your friends you hang out with
 - Strangers or acquaintances
 - At your job or school
