God is Sovereign

- He is in Control....
- 3 times in the first 6 verses Jesus references the will of the Father
 - ³⁸not to do my own will but the will of him who sent me.
 - ³⁹ And this is the will of him who sent me,
 - ⁴⁰ For this is the will of my Father

> The Scriptures Say

- Isaiah 46:9-10⁹ remember the former things of old; for I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me, ¹⁰ declaring the end from the beginning and from ancient times things not yet done, saying, 'My counsel shall stand, and I will accomplish all my purpose,'
- Jer. 32:27, "Behold, I am the Lord, the God of all flesh; is anything too difficult for Me?"

> You may Say... I believe God is All Powerful and in Control...

- I would never doubt that... Its a no brainer
- Do you Really...
- Lets look at how easy it is to doubt God and what that looks like...
 - With our Pleasures... Do you lack the Faith that God is enough for you, so you look elswhere
 - Do you always feel as if God is control of your Family
 - Do you believe God is in control of your health
 - What about your finances
 - Do You believe God Will provide Your needs...
- Actions Speak Louder than Words...
- The Reason We Struggle With our understanding of God's Power and Might in our Lives...
 - 1) Is because many of us live under His discipline...
 - We do not get His blessings because of our disobedience...
 - We do not believe in a works related Salvation.... That is a free gift...
 - But, God will not reward Disobedience to Him...
 - Therefore We doubt God's control over our job situation
 - Or our finances...
 - Or our Family and Health
 - Because We are not walking in Faith and Obedience with our God
 - And b/c he loves us, He disciplines us, to bring us closer to Him
 - 2) Our Lack of Biblical Knowledge and Faith have Warped our Knowledge of His Wisdom
 - Simply Put: We do not like how He does things!
- If We Grow Closer to Him Daily:
 - We will not only like how He does Things, But Rejoice that He does it that way....
 - I am not saying it is easy...
 - Romans 11:33 ³³ O the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! how unsearchable *are* his judgments, and his ways past finding out!

◆ 1) Jesus Is All We Need (I can not seem to do this point Justice.... So I ask the H.S. to Help Greatly)

- ³⁵ Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me shall not hunger, and whoever believes in me shall never thirst.
- ⁴⁷ Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes has eternal life.
- ⁴⁸ I am the bread of life.
- ⁵⁰ This is the bread that comes down from heaven, so that one may eat of it and not die.

• ⁵¹ I am the living bread that came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever. And the bread that I will give for the life of the world is my flesh."

> 1) He is the Bread of Life

- Jesus Becomes Very Straightforward and to the point
 - Vs 35 "I Am the Bread of Life
 - Vs 48 "I Am the Bread of Life
 - Vs 50 "This is the bread that comes down from heaven"
 - Vs 51 "I am the living bread that came down from heaven"
 - Vs 51 "The bread that I will give for the life of the world is my flesh"
 - And They Get it... They hear what He is saying...
 - ⁴² They said, "Is not this Jesus, the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know? How does he now say, 'I have come down from heaven'?"
 - Yet they still don't get it!

> 2) A Different Kind of Bread:

- Of Life
- Comes down from Heaven
- Living Bread
- He gives Bread

> 3) His Flesh is the Bread

- And here we see what He is getting at after all of this time...
- ⁵¹And the bread that I will give for the life of the world is my flesh."
 - He had not been beating around the bush or anything...
 - But, He was speaking Spiritually and the people were not getting it...
 - So He just spells it out for them....
- He is Like: LISTEN UP... What I am Saying is...
 - My flesh is this bread I keep talking about...
- > 4) The Flesh of Jesus Gives Life for the World...
 - There is something beyond our understanding about the Flesh of Jesus....
 - I do not want us to pass over the importance of the flesh of the Son of God
 - In the O.T. We see a model of sacrifice with lambs and bulls...
 - And their life had to be taken, so that the sins of men could be covered for a short time...
 - In the N.T. We see John the Baptist calling Jesus the Lamb of God...
 - And Remember how we looked at what a provocative statement that would be...
 - Because it meant a dying sacrifice...
 - Jesus Became a Man for us....
 - The Son of God left His glory to be a servant in the form of man...
 - To live a perfect a blameless life...
 - So He could offer up His perfect Sinless Flesh as a Substitute for ours...
 - The <u>sinlessness</u> of the flesh of Jesus' and the <u>very nature</u> of who He is...
 - Produces something so Supernatural and Powerful...

• That it is Able to Provide Life for the World

- OH PRAISE GOD over this, this morning!
- > 5) This Life Sustains all of our Hunger and all of our Thirst
 - whoever comes to me shall not hunger, and whoever believes in me shall never thirst.
 - The Reason He is Able to do this is Because...
 - He can satisfy that hunger and thirst within you that nothing else can...
 - And He will satisfy you forever

- In the Same Way Physical Bread We Eat Helps Keep life in our Physical Bodies
 - The Bread that is the Flesh of Jesus... Creates a constant Life Giving Source for us...
- > 6) He is Not Like the Temporary Satisfactions We Find on this Earth....
 - He contrasts Himself with what their Fathers received in the Wilderness
 - ⁴⁹ Your fathers ate the manna in the wilderness, and they died.
 - Remember how they wrongly thought of Moses as the giver of that bread instead of God...
 - They saw that bread as a great miracle
 - And it was
 - But even the supernatural bread that came daily for practically 40 years...
 - Did not keep them from dying...
- > 7) As Living Bread, Jesus Gives us Eternal Life
 - When Adam and Even are kicked out of the garden of Eden...
 - They leave behind the Tree of Life... They can no longer eat from the Tree of Life...
 - But, now... Here comes Jesus... And He is that tree of Life...
 - He is the source of All life...
 - John 1.4 "In Him Was Life"
- > 8) What Happens is summed up in John 4 in regards to Water
 - John 4:14 ¹⁴ but whoever drinks of the water that I will give him will never be thirsty again. The water that I will give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life."
 - It Becomes a Constant Source of Sustaining Life.
 - We Never Hunger or Thirst Again b/c
 - 1) Our Hunger and Thirst for Eternal Life has Been Met
 - 2) When We do Hunger and Thirst for God, There is a Perpetual Fountain

> Application:

- Do you understand the Ramifications of Jesus being All We Need?
- Do you find all you need in Jesus?
- Spend Time Meditating on what this means....

✤ 2) Jesus Knows Man's Disbelief

- ³⁶ But I said to you that you have seen me and yet do not believe.
- ⁴¹ So the Jews grumbled about him, because he said, "I am the bread that came down from heaven." ⁴² They said, "Is not this Jesus, the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know? How does he now say, 'I have come down from heaven'?" ⁴³ Jesus answered them, "Do not grumble among yourselves.
- > Remember Back Through the Unbelief that Jesus Came Across So Far in John....
 - Starting With... John 2
 - John 2:23-25 Now when he was in Jerusalem at the Passover Feast, many believed in his name when they saw the signs that he was doing. 24 But Jesus on his part did not entrust himself to them, because he knew all people 25 and needed no one to bear witness about man, for he himself knew what was in man.
 - Jesus Must Give Himself To the Person...
 - Then in Ch. 3 We See Nicodemus as Exhibit A
 - John 3:1-3 Now there was a man of the Pharisees named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews. 2 This man came to Jesus by night and said to him, "Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher come from God, for no one can do these signs that you do unless God is with him." 3 Jesus answered him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God."
 - After Healing of Lame Man in Ch. 5

- John 5:38-40 ³⁸ and you do not have his word abiding in you, for you do not believe the one whom he has sent. ³⁹ You search the Scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life; and it is they that bear witness about me, ⁴⁰ yet you refuse to come to me that you may have life.
- In John 7 We will see that not even His brothers Believed in who He was
- Demons Believe
- > These Things Are For Our Self Evaluation...
 - There may be no point more important for some in here than this one here...
 - Understanding the differences between belief unto salvation and belief unto destruction
- > Do You Believe In Faith Who He Is...
 - Those Who believed in the Bible... The First Fruit We see...
 - Is they Followed...
 - They Left Their Former Life to Follow...
 - And they Make their Decisions Based on Faith in What He wants for their Life...
 - Even when it may seem odd to many around them

✤ 3) We Benefit From God's Will

- ³⁸ For I have come down from heaven, not to do my own will but the will of him who sent me.
- ³⁹ And this is the will of him who sent me, that I should lose nothing of all that he has given me, but raise it up on the last day.
- ⁴⁰ For this is the will of my Father, that everyone who looks on the Son and believes in him should have eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day."
- Jesus is All About the Father's Will
- It is God's Will That Our Life is Secure in Jesus
- It is God's Will That We be Raised Up
- > It is God's Will That Everyone Who Looks on the Son and Believes Has Eternal Life
- God is Sovereign
 - When He wants Something Accomplished, It is Accomplished...
 - No Matter What The Obstacles Are
 - Daniel 4:34-35 ³⁴ At the end of the days I, Nebuchadnezzar, lifted my eyes to heaven, and my reason returned to me, and I blessed the Most High, and praised and honored him who lives forever, for his dominion is an everlasting dominion, and his kingdom endures from generation to generation; ³⁵ all the inhabitants of the earth are accounted as nothing, and he does according to his will among the host of heaven and among the inhabitants of the earth; and none can stay his hand or say to him, "What have you done?"
- ➢ We Are The Beneficiaries of God's Will

4) We Will Be Raised By Christ (A Great Benefit)

- ³⁹ And this is the will of him who sent me, that I should lose nothing of all that he has given me, but raise it up on the last day.
- ⁴⁰ For this is the will of my Father, that everyone who looks on the Son and believes in him should have eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day."
- ⁴⁴ No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him. And I will raise him up on the last day.
- Who is Raised?
 - All Those Who Have Been Given to Jesus....
 - Everyone Who Looks on the Son and Believes
 - Those Who come To Jesus by the Father's Drawing

- > We Will Be Raised...
 - This brings up a lot of questions...
 - Like:
 - I thought when we died we went immediately to heaven...
 - Why then would we be raised, if we are already up...
 - When We Die We Go to Be With God Immediately
 - Jesus Soul Left His Physical Body...
 - And then He reunited with the Body and raised it up
 - 2 Corinthians 5:8⁸ We are confident, *I say*, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.
 - The Martyrs under the Throne
 - God Will reunite us with our bodies and change them to be like Him
 - 1 John 3:2² Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it does not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.
 - 1 Thess 4 teaches that the dead in Christ will rise first....
 - But that He will also bring them with Him when He returns...
 - It is indeed a mystery.... but...
- > The Main Point Here is:
 - You can get caught up in the logistics...
 - And they really do not matter cause we can not control any of it anyway...
 - We have no say in it...
 - Jesus is assuring His Followers... That No matter what happens on this earth...
 - I will Raise You Up...
 - I Will Raise You Up....
- > The Hope of Resurrection Creates Resilience in the Face of Adversity
- > Application:
 - How Secure Are You? Do you Know You Will Be Raised...
 - I am not asking what you tell everybody...
 - I am asking how you answer that when no one is listening
 - When you lay down on your pillow at night
 - To Those Who know This... And Yes You can Know it...
 - Faith Creates a Knowledge that can not be explained or denied
 - Do you rejoice over this...
 - Doesn't it create hope within you... It should...
 - Some Religions:
 - Believe that we will just be annihilated after death...
 - Some think they will go through a time of suffering...
 - Some believe we will just come back in another form...
 - Jesus says He will Raise us to be with Him!
- Invitation

✤ 5) Our Life is Secure With Jesus

- ³⁷ All that the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never cast out.
- ³⁹ And this is the will of him who sent me, that I should lose nothing of all that he has given me,
- I Will Never Cast Out
- Lose Nothing

6) We Are Brought To Jesus By the Father

- ³⁷All that the Father gives me will come to me,
- ⁴⁴ No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him.
- ⁴⁵Everyone who has heard and learned from the Father comes to me—
- > Example:
 - Those People that Like to Get Recognition for what others have done...
 - Presidents are the worse...
 - All of them... I am not being biased... doesn't matter what party you like...
 - I do not recall very many HUMBLE Politicians...
 - I am sure there are SOME...
- > This Shoots Down Any Thoughts of Self Glory
 - What Jesus says here takes away all the glory anyone could ever claim for their own salvation
 - No one can say, they just got tired or fed up with themselves so decided to clean it up
 - No one can claim that they had the idea of coming to God.
- > We come to God because God draws us.
 - Vs 37 Will come to me
 - Vs 44 no one comes unless drawn by Father
 - Vs 45 those who hear and learn from Father come to Jesus
- God Deserves the Recognition
 - God Deserves all the glory and all the praise for our Salvation...
- > We Should Be Unconcerned About How This Affects our Preconceived Ideas of God
 - We should not allow our misunderstandings about the nature of God
 - To hinder us from moving forward in our understanding of who He is...
- God's Work is Primary
- \triangleright

7) It is Our Responsibility to Come to Christ

- ³⁵ whoever comes to me shall not hunger, and whoever believes in me shall never thirst.
- ³⁷ and whoever comes to me I will never cast out.
- ⁴⁷ whoever believes has eternal life.
- ⁵¹ If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever.
- > Our Coming is Real, But Dependent on the Work of God

End Note: Believing and Partaking of The Bread of Christ Should Consume Our Life

- > This Should Be Our Number 1 objective in Life
- > Nothing Else Should Be A Close Second
- > The Work of God is That We Believe and Partake of the Bread
 - Remember what they asked Jesus:
 - John 6:28-29 ²⁸ Then they said to him, "What must we do, to be doing the works of God?" ²⁹ Jesus answered them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in him whom he has sent."
 - The Bread He is referring to is the Flesh of Jesus Christ.

> How do We Partake of the Eternal Bread...?

- By Believing in the Death of Jesus Christ on the Cross
 - As: The Appeasement of the Wrath of God on Sinful Man
 - As: The Replacement for Your Punishment
 - As: A Sufficient and Able Payment for your wrongs
 - As: The Only Way You are Made Right With God
