And I will raise him up on the last day. 45 It is written in the Prophets, 'And they will all be taught by God.' Everyone who has heard and learned from the Father comes to me— ⁴⁶ not that anyone has seen the Father except he who is from God; he has seen the Father. ⁴⁷ Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes has eternal life. ⁴⁸ I am the bread of life. ⁴⁹ Your fathers ate the manna in the wilderness, and they died. ⁵⁰ This is the bread that comes down from heaven, so that one may eat of it and not die. ⁵¹I am the living bread that came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever. And the bread that I will give for the life of the world is my flesh."

2) Jesus Knows Man's Disbelief

- Remember that Not All "believing" is true believing that leads to eternal life
 - Make Sure You believe in the Real Jesus... Not an image

Why do You Need to Listen Intently? Why do you need to understand these things...

- Every week... there is a spiritual battle going on around you... (Even if you do not believe it)
 - And the forces of evil know that the WORD of God can
 - Wake You Up...
 - Cause You to be made alive spiritually...

> Your Life Depends on It...

- There is a real spiritual being that wants your harm...
- Not to just kill you... but to destroy you and bring you great harm

Major Causes for Rejoicing...

- There are some points that should just make us happy
 - They are better than the best Christmas present you ever received
 - Or Holiday bonus, or Raise, or even beautiful wife
- If you notice them give me at least a nod... (Mr Lynn.... You can say Amen)

3) Our Life is Secure With Jesus (What a Cause for Rejoicing)

- All that the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never cast out.
- ³⁹ And this is the will of him who sent me, that I should lose nothing of all that he has given me,

> 1) I Will Never Cast Out

- Cast out means to expel or to drive away
- Explanation...
 - The example of sheep... He uses sheep to describe us....
 - When the shepherd is bring in the sheep, he is gathering them... and as they come into the fold, or the fence you have for them...
 - You are trying to get them in....
 - You are not trying to run them off...
 - You would run off a predator... like a wolf or coyote... Or you may run off some goats that do not belong to this group of sheep...
 - And once you get them in there, you are not going to run them off, or expel them...
 - You want them in the fold... Even the sick ones... You certainly want them... so you can heal them....

EVEN MORE SO...

- Whoever comes to me... Because they have been given to Jesus by the Father...
- Jesus says I will NEVER cast them out...
 - ♦ A brief lesson on Never:
 - It means that there is no chance in all of time and even past time, that this will happen...
 - > It means never...
 - ➤ There are no, but what if... Never...!
 - ➤ What if if mess up... Never!
 - What if I do not read my Bible enough... Never!
 - What if I do not understand everything... Never!

2) Lose Nothing

- Not only will he Never cast you out...
 - He will never lose you either...

- Because you may be wondering... Well, he might not do it on purpose... but what if I fall through the cracks...
- Your Asking: Could Jesus perhaps misplace me? NO...
- Lose: means to lose... or fail to get...
 - He will not fail to find you... or to get you...

➤ I am Certain:

- Nothing will ever keep Aiden and Mia from Being my Children
- And Nothing Will Change my relationship with God....
 - Romans 8:37-39 ³⁷ No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. ³⁸ For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, ³⁹ nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

> All who come to Him...

- We learn something else here as well... For our assurance...
 - ³⁷ All that the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never cast out.
- ...will come to me, and whoever comes to me...
 - Whenever you come to Him, for the saving of your soul... He will receive you...
 - Jesus will receive all who come to Him, and He will never reject them...
 - Praise God for His kindness and faithfulness...

4) We Are Brought To Jesus By the Father (Rejoicing)

- ³⁷All that the Father gives me will come to me,
- ⁴⁴ No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him.
- ⁴⁵Everyone who has heard and learned from the Father comes to me—

Example:

- Those People that Like to Get Recognition for what others have done...
 - Presidents are the worse...
 - All of them... I am not being biased... doesn't matter what party you like...
 - I do not recall very many HUMBLE Politicians...
 - ♦ I am sure there are SOME...

> This Shoots Down Any Thoughts of Self Glory

- What Jesus says here takes away all the glory anyone could ever claim for their own salvation
- No one can say, they just got tired or fed up with themselves so decided to clean it up
- No one can claim that they had the idea of coming to God.

We come to God because God draws us.

- Vs 37 Will come to me
- Vs 44 no one comes unless drawn by Father
- Vs 45 those who hear and learn from Father come to Jesus

God Deserves the Recognition

God Deserves all the glory and all the praise for our Salvation...

We Should Be Unconcerned About How This Affects our Preconceived Ideas of God

- We should not allow our misunderstandings about the nature of God and Man
 - To hinder us from moving forward in our understanding of who He is...
 - And We have so many... that we never find in the bible... lets look at two...

> 1) Preconceived Idea Number 1 – Man is inherently good

- No... Man is inherently rebellious toward God, and therefore evil.
- Being Rebellious toward a Holy God would mean you were the opposite of that...
- And the opposite of Holy, would be evil...

- Let me give you just one of many proof verses in the Bible...
 - Romans 3:9-12 ⁹ What then? Are we Jews any better off? No, not at all. For we have already charged that all, both Jews and Greeks, are under sin, ¹⁰ as it is written: "None is righteous, no, not one; ¹¹ no one understands; no one seeks for God. ¹² All have turned aside; together they have become worthless; no one does good, not even one."
- If it were left up to man and His goodness.... NO ONE WOULD EVER COME TO GOD
 - The Alternative to God decisively drawing, is that none come

> 2) Preconceived Idea Number 2 – God is required to draw all men to Jesus

- God is free to act in any way He desires
- He is not required to save any of rebellious man...
- It would be an act of justice if all were condemned...
- But God has chosen to show us Mercy... and offers ups His Son... So We may have Life

Application

> You May Say:

- Well... I want that.... I want Him to draw me...
 - I want to gain eternal life...
 - What can I do then, Am I destined to just sit and wait and hope He draws me...
 - Do I even have a chance
- You should pray and ask for Him to draw you and save you from your sins...
 - James 4:8 ⁸ Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded.
 - James says in 4.2 We do not have because we do not ask.
- Then You will Realize:
 - That desire for God has been given to you by God
 - And He has been drawing you the whole time...
 - And His main mode of drawing men to Him, is through His Word... Through the Bible

Application: Should Give You confidence as a Christian today...

- That you can go to the Father and ask Him to save your loved one...
- And it is His will that none perish...
- And He loves to hear from and answer His children's prayers...
- And it doesn't matter that your loved one doesn't love God, nor wants to come to God...
 - If God draws Him... He will come to Jesus...
 - ³⁷All that the Father gives me will come to me,

❖ 5) It is Our Responsibility to Come to Christ

- whoever comes to me shall not hunger, and whoever believes in me shall never thirst.
- ³⁷ and whoever comes to me I will never cast out.
- 47 whoever believes has eternal life.
- If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever.

> Our Coming is Real, But Dependent on the Work of God

- Whoever comes to me...
- Whoever believes in me
- Whoever come to me
- Whoever believes
- If anyone eats...

> Do you see our responsibility to come...?

- We must come to Christ, or be lost forever...
- We are responsible for our rejecting...

- We are responsible for our apathy of just saying... I will later...
- There is not maybe... There is yes or no...
- We either come to Him and believe on Him...
 - Or we do not...

6) We Will Be Raised By Christ (A Great Benefit) (Rejoicing)

- ³⁹ And this is the will of him who sent me, that I should lose nothing of all that he has given me, but raise it up on the last day.
- ⁴⁰ For this is the will of my Father, that everyone who looks on the Son and believes in him should have eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day."
- ⁴⁴ No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him. And I will raise him up on the last day.

➤ Who is Raised?

- All Those Who Have Been Given to Jesus....
- Everyone Who Looks on the Son and Believes
- Those Who come To Jesus by the Father's Drawing

➤ We Will Be Raised...

- This brings up a lot of questions...
- Like:
 - I thought when we died we went immediately to heaven...
 - Why then would we be raised, if we are already up...
- When We Die We Go to Be With God Immediately
 - Jesus' Soul Left His Physical Body...
 - ♦ And then He reunited with the Body and raised it up
 - ♦ 2 Corinthians 5:8 ⁸ We are confident, *I say*, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.
 - ♦ The Martyrs under the Throne
- God Will reunite us with our bodies and change them to be like Him
 - 1 John 3:2 ² Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it does not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.
 - 1 Thess 4 teaches that the dead in Christ will rise first....
 - ♦ But that He will also bring them with Him when He returns...
 - ♦ It is indeed a mystery.... but...

> The Main Point Here is:

- You can get caught up in the logistics...
 - And they really do not matter cause we can not control any of it anyway...
 - We have no say in it...
- Jesus is assuring His Followers... That No matter what happens on this earth...
 - I Will Raise You Up... I Will Raise You Up....
- > The Hope of Resurrection Creates Resilience in the Face of Adversity

> Application:

- How Secure Are You? Do you Know You Will Be Raised...
- I am not asking what you tell everybody...
- I am asking how you answer that when no one is listening
- When you lay down on your pillow at night
- To Those Who know This... And Yes You can Know it...
 - Faith Creates a Knowledge that can not be explained or denied
 - Do you rejoice over this...

- Doesn't it create hope within you... It should...
- Some Religions:
 - Believe that we will just be annihilated after death...
 - Some think they will go through a time of suffering...
 - Some believe we will just come back in another form...
 - Jesus says He will Raise us to be with Him!

7) God's Will is Our Assurance (Rejoicing)

- 38 For I have come down from heaven, not to do my own will but the will of him who sent me.
- ³⁹ And this is the will of him who sent me, that I should lose nothing of all that he has given me, but raise it up on the last day.
- ⁴⁰ For this is the will of my Father, that everyone who looks on the Son and believes in him should have eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day."
- > Jesus is All About the Father's Will
- ➤ It is God's Will That Our Life is Secure in Jesus
- It is God's Will That We be Raised Up
- > It is God's Will That Everyone Who Looks on the Son and Believes Has Eternal Life
- God is Sovereign
 - When He wants Something Accomplished, It is Accomplished...
 - No Matter What The Obstacles Are
 - Isaiah 46:9-10 "I am God and there is no other; I am God, and there Is none like me, declaring the end from the beginning and from ancient time things not yet done, saying, 'My counsel shall stand, and I will accomplish all my purpose."

These Things Jesus says

- > 1) Should humble us before God
- > 2) Create thankfulness in our hearts
- > 3) And Motivate us to live engaged lives for Him
- ➤ 4) Cause us to Examine Ourselves to See if We are in the Faith... Truly Saved...
 - Tim Keller said "Religion says: I obey, therefore I am accepted. The Gospel says: I am accepted therefore I obey...
 - Do you follow Jesus?

End Note: Believing and Partaking of The Bread of Christ Should Consume Our Life

- > This Should Be Our Number 1 objective in Life
- Nothing Else Should Be A Close Second
- The Work of God is That We Believe and Partake of the Bread
 - Remember what they asked Jesus:
 - John 6:28-29 ²⁸ Then they said to him, "What must we do, to be doing the works of God?" ²⁹ Jesus answered them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in him whom he has sent."
 - The Bread He is referring to is the Flesh of Jesus Christ.
- ➤ How do We Partake of the Eternal Bread...?
 - By Believing in the Death of Jesus Christ on the Cross
 - As: The Appeasement of the Wrath of God on Sinful Man
 - As: The Replacement for Your Punishment
 - As: A Sufficient and Able Payment for your wrongs
 - As: The Only Way You are Made Right With God
- > Have You Repented of Your Wrongs And Believed These Things About Jesus?
