So they are without excuse. <sup>21</sup> For although they knew God, they did not honor him as God or give thanks to him, but they became futile in their thinking, and their foolish hearts were darkened. <sup>22</sup> Claiming to be wise, they became fools, <sup>23</sup> and exchanged the glory of the immortal God for images resembling mortal man and birds and animals and creeping things.

### Intro

- > It is Imperative for everyone here today...
  - To come to an understanding of the Wrath of Almighty God...
- > Let's Briefly Define and illustrate what we mean by God's Wrath...
  - so as we continue, you understand...
  - God's Wrath is: an attribute of God...
    - it is a characteristic of God... just like love and Eternality are attributes of God...
    - It could be defined as God's necessary and just retribution against sin...
      - it is an angry response to sin and in some ways it is currently being held back
    - Our Response to the wrath of God should be the same as our Response to His Grace
      - Praise and Adoration...
      - We often times praise God for his Grace and Love and Mercy
      - But the Wrath of God is as much an attribute as any other...
      - For God would not be God... without His burning hot anger against sin
  - A Few Verses that Describe God's Wrath
    - **"Behold** the storm of the LORD! Wrath has gone forth, a whirling tempest; it will burst upon the head of the wicked." (Jeremiah 30:23)
    - **"The LORD** is a jealous and avenging God; the LORD is avenging and wrathful; the Lord takes vengeance on his adversaries and keeps wrath for his enemies." (Nahum 1:2)
    - He will tread the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God the Almighty." (Rev 19:15)
    - It is expressed as a great/terrible storm ready to wreak havoc on those in its path
      - It is seen as being kept in storage for His enemies

#### • We see another element in the verse from revelation...

- > Where God's wrath is described as being furious...
- > As the Son of God treads the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God...
- > Fury is defined as a wild and violent anger...

### Illustrated...

- God's wrath could be illustrated by a great tornado...
  - Records indicate tornadoes have travelled as fast as 73 mph
  - They have travelled on ground as far as 219 miles
  - They have lasted as long as 3.5 hours... Some can reach a width of 2.6 miles
  - They can kill a thousand people... It can have winds over 300 mph
  - Tornadoes are considered the finger of God... simply the finger...
- God's Wrath could be likened to a Wild Fire burning out of control
  - Burning everything in its way
  - The heat is unbarable...
  - The fire is unquenchable destroying almost everything it comes into contact with
  - It can reach temperatures over 1200 degrees celsius
  - And the smoke from the fire can choke a person...
- These are wimps in comparison to Power and Might of the Wrath of God
  - Oh... the power and the might of Almighty God...!

#### > We have been so saturated with a man made idea of God...

- Of a God that is grandfatherly and accepting of us...
- Man has come to a point where they have exchanged the true God
- For one that fits snugly in their pocket...

### > Today's god in many Christian churches...

- Is a god overly concerned with the physical and emotional health of the person...
- He is overly concerned with the financial wealth of his people...
- Today's god is man centric...Not that He is unconcerned... because He is...
- He is fine with our sins and failures and will not judge harshly ...
  - God must be placed first... and then man because God loves man

# > You may think... I am a Christian... and I would never make up a god for myself...

- Then why is it so easy for us to live in unrepentant sin?
- Why is it so easy for you to dismiss the importance of Bible Reading and Memorization
- Why do so few of us pray purposeful God glorifying prayers
- Why does your god take up so little of your time?

### > It is ASSANINE to create a god in your own mind...

It is ludicrous to think God is one way or another based off your feelings or emotions...

### > ONE FINAL THOUGHT:

- You can Never be born again without some understanding of the wrath of Almighty God
- It is not until the Holy Spirit brings conviction to your soul
  - That God is Holy and You have sinned...
  - And you are deserving of God's eternal wrath upon your soul
  - And God is totally justified in giving it...
- It is not until then can one Repent and Trust in Christ...
  - So, if that has never happened to you through the power of the Spirit...
  - Then you will have been unable to Repent unto salvation thus far...

### Understanding God's Anger Toward Sin: Reveals the Beauty of the Gospel

#### I) God's Wrath is Against Man

- <sup>18</sup> For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness <u>of men</u>, who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth.
- > Let's Deal with to whom God's wrath is revealed...
  - From the text we see that it is revealed... and we will get into the how...
    - and to what extent... But, let's start with who
- It is Toward Mankind...
  - I think it is plain that we do not want to trifle with God
    - He is not one to mess with... and we should be very aware of that...
  - The God we know of today... is the same God who burned hot against sin in the O.T.
  - God's anger is not here spoken of against the idea of sin....
    - The thought of sin...
    - It is indeed against the sinning man...
      - Ephesians 2:3b and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind.
- Remember God's Dealing with Sinful Man...
  - God's wrath burned red hot against the people of this world in the days of Noah...
    - So He sent a flood to destroy all mankind except for 8 people
    - Genesis 6:11-13<sup>11</sup> Now the earth was corrupt in God's sight, and the earth was filled with violence. <sup>12</sup> And God saw the earth, and behold, it was corrupt, for all flesh had corrupted their way on the earth. <sup>13</sup> And God said to Noah, "I have determined to make an end of all flesh, for the earth is filled with violence through them. Behold, I will destroy them with the earth.
  - God's Wrath Burned Against Egypt
    - The Land of Egypt was filled with false gods...
    - And they enslaved the people of Israel... And Pharaoh would not honor God
    - So God sent 10 plagues upon the people of Egypt...
      - the last one taking the lives of all the first born of the Egyptians...
  - God's Wrath burned hot against the land of canaan...
    - So, God uses the young nation of Israel to judge the people of Cannan
    - And they would destroy many cities and peoples
    - Because they had done detestable things for their false gods
    - Even burning their children for false gods
  - God's Wrath Burned Against His Own People of Israel
    - For they had forsaken God... and committed spiritual adultery
    - By worshipping false gods... and perverted justice and forsaking God's ways...
    - So, God raised up Assyria and the Babylonians...
      - And He destroyed the nation of Israel... and they suffered mightily
      - And were carried off into captivity...
  - Do not Forget God's Wrath at the Fall...
    - When Adam and Eve sinned... God cursed man to death
    - He cast Adam and Eve from the garden
    - And mankind was subjected to living with a sinful nature
  - 4 Examples against certain individuals...
    - When aaron's sons Nadab and Abihu did not follow God's instruction for incense...
      - And they burned unauthorized fire before the Lord

- God sent fire down from heaven to consume them
- King Nebuchadnezzar's boast that he built Babylon caused God to remove him
  - And he was like an animal for 7 years
- Uzzah was struck down by the Lord...
  - Because He touched the Ark of God with his unclean hands...
  - He thought He was helping, but He was disobedient...
- King Herod took the praise of men as the called him a God
- So God struck him down and he died of worms...
- There are Many others from the Bible...
  - Plus many more throughout all of History...
  - From Rome to Hitler to Napoleon
  - God will only allow sin for so long before executing judgment...
- God has not changed!

# > God's wrath is against man

 John 3:36 Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God **remains** on him.

# 3) God's Wrath is Against all Ungodliness

- Now let's get specific and see what it is about man that causes God's wrath to be revealed
  - <sup>18</sup> For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all <u>ungodliness</u> and unrighteousness of men, who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth.

# > Ungodliness

- Here Paul is going to say ungodliness and unrighteousness...
- And they are two different terms... obviously...
- Although, when used by themselves... they indicate the other...
- Meaning, if you were to see ungodliness alone in the scripture, you would assume:
  - Unrighteousness as well... and vice verse...
- > Ungodliness is: A Failure or refusal in any way to live to God's glory
  - Ungodliness is when men fail to honor and worship God as they ought...
  - So... ungodliness is us in relation to God
- > This is made plain for us in the greatest commandment...
  - Matthew 22:37 <sup>37</sup> And he said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.
  - Any failure to do this... is ungodliness...
  - If you notice... we are not just wondering if you have told a lie...
    - Or if you have stolen something...
  - Have you lived your life in such a way as to bring honor to God at all times?
- > How Are We Doing?
  - God's Wrath is Revealed from Heaven against all Ungodliness of men
    - Against a failure to love God with their heart, soul and mind
  - Isn't this what Paul is getting at down in verse 21
    - Romans 1:21 <sup>21</sup> For although they knew God, they did not honor him as God or give thanks to him,

# 3) God's Wrath is Against all Unrighteousness

- <sup>18</sup> For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and <u>unrighteousness</u> of men, who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth.
- > God's wrath is revealed against ungodliness and unrighteousness...
  - Ungodliness comes first... and rightly so...
  - Because any failure to put God first in your life is ungodliness...

- And any failure to put God first in your life results in unrighteousness
  - If ungodliness is man in relation to God...
  - Unrighteousness can be seen in man's relation to other men...
- > **Unrighteousness is** any <u>deviation</u> from right behavior, speech or thought
  - It is not right behavior... it is wrong behavior
  - Unrighteousness focuses on how we behave...
  - Ungodliness leads to unrighteousness...
- > Again... This is made plain for us in the second greatest commandment...
  - Matt 22:39 <sup>39</sup> And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself.
  - First, we see we are to love God with everything... then love our neighbor as ourself
    - That is godliness and righteousness
    - Since... All men fail to be godly... it means all men fail to be righteous
- > Let's Consider together the Depth of our Unrighteous Acts
  - Lets consider them in regards to the Sins of Children (Listen up Children)
  - A Child will lie to their parents, siblings or friends...
    - They will withhold the truth... Why?
      - I do not think they understand why... but... a person would lie for many reasons
    - A Child will lie because they know what they did was forbidden...
      - So they lie to not have to **face** the consequences...
    - They will commit the act they lied about... because... Sometimes
      - They do not see it is hurtful
      - They think... it isn't hurting anyone... therefore... I can do this...
    - They also lie so they can make themselves **look** better....
      - If they lie... they are not found out to be disobedient, or lazy or unkind... or whatever it would reveal...
  - At the Center of it all is a Self Centeredness...
    - The self is the king of the child's universe...
    - This applies to a child stealing... or saying hurtful things, or a child hurting another child... maybe they hit them, or tripped them, or played a joke on them...
    - The main thing we see is what?
      - Self Centeredness...
        - > And if Self is the center of our life... Do you know who is not?
        - > God is not...
- > Notice: The Root of Sin even in the sweetest of Children in here today...
  - Is to **dethrone** God in their lives...
  - And to place themselves squarely on the throne of their life...
    - I use the example of children, so that even the most innocent in here today
      - Are able to see clearly their **guilt** before Almighty God...
      - If our children do not escape guilt today... then what about the rest of us?

> Ok... God's Wrath is revealed against Man and his ungodliness and unrighteousness

### ✤ 4) God's Wrath is Against Men Who Suppress the Truth

- <sup>18</sup> For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, <u>who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth.</u>
- > A quick look at the verse, and you notice...
  - Paul is not talking about different categories of men
  - He is talking about men who are ungodly and unrighteous and suppress the truth
- > 1) Suppress the truth
  - Notice first what they do... they suppress the truth...
  - Suppress here **means**... to hold it back or to push it down... you do not let it out

- Paul also explains this in the next verse...
  - <sup>19</sup> For what can be known about God is plain to them, because God has shown it to them.
  - Paul explains suppressing the truth as:
    - Taking something that God has made plain to them...
    - Something God has made evident to them...
    - Going even further... Something God has shown to them...
      - > We can go even further here... the meaning of "shown to them"
      - > Is literally... "made it known" AND pushing down what is known
- What Truth are they Supressing?
  - Look to verse 20
    - Romans 1:20 For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made.
      - > 2 things: God is God and He is an All Powerful God... Repeat...
- **Paul explains** suppressing the truth is taking what God has made known to them
  - And holding it down...
  - And in verse 21 we see what they do with that truth...
    - Romans 1:21 For although they knew God, they did not honor him as God or give thanks to him,
    - They do not honor God or give him thanks...
      - > They do not submit to the truth that God is God and He is powerful...
      - > They do not live for Him... or express gratitude for what He has done...
- Now... notice... saying with the mouth that God is God and He is Powerful...
  - Does not keep man from suppressing the truth...
    - Look at how they suppress the truth...
- > 2) Who... by their unrighteousness suppress the truth
  - Notice secondly... how they suppress the truth...
    - By their unrighteousness...
    - In their deeds the suppress the truth...
  - Here is the how and the why they suppress the truth all rolled into one thing...
    - By their unrighteousness... by their deeds... with their deeds
    - Look at what Jesus said in John 3
      - John 3:19-20 <sup>19</sup> And this is the judgment: the light has come into the world, and people loved the darkness rather than the light because their works were evil.
        <sup>20</sup> For everyone who does wicked things hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his works should be exposed.
      - Clearly... there is a suppression of truth because people love their sins...
        - > Isn't that what is being said here rather plainly...
        - > Men do not want to come to the Light... come to God...
          - Because they do not want their sins exposed...

### How do we suppress the truth?

- Anytime we act in an unrighteous manner...
  - we are suppressing the truth that God is God, and He is All Powerful
  - Because... we are not living in a way that shows we believe God is God
  - We are not honoring him as God
- What are we doing...?
  - We are like self centered children... Enthroning ourselves as Kings of Self
  - We know that as we grow out of childhood, we grow ever increasingly self centered

- Self glorifying...
- Unless we have help changing...
- > The unrighteousness of man
  - Leads to a suppression of the truth about God... It leads to a failure to submit to God
- > Result: The Revealing of God's Wrath

#### S) God's Wrath is Revealed

 <sup>18</sup> For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth.

## > The Wrath of God is Revealed...

- Notice: In verse 17 that the righteousness of God is revealed...
  - For in it (the gospel) the righteousness of God is revealed from faith for faith
- There are 2 things being revealed here in these two verses...
  - 1) The righteousness of God 2) The Wrath of God...
- They are both in the same tense...
  - God's righteousness is presently and continually being revealed... and
  - God's wrath is presently and continually be revealed...
- We explained previously...
  - The gospel reveals God's righteousness...
    - It reveals it by showing us that God would not allow sin to go unpunished...
    - So, God punishes his Son on the cross...
    - And that is at the heart of the gospel... And it is how the gospel reveals...
      - God's righteousness...
      - $\succ$  He is so righteous as to be the one to bear the consequences of sin for man

### How Is God' Wrath Being Revealed?

- God's Current Revealing of Wrath is Proof and Warning of Future Wrath
- 1) In Our Conscience
  - Within the person... there is an understanding of the wrath of God...
  - Because, when we see something that is terribly wrong... it causes anger inside man
  - People can not sit back and see someone blatantly taken advantage of...
  - And be morally ambiguous toward it... they have a moral response
- 2) In Sin
  - God's allowance of sin is a continual show of His wrath
  - Sometimes God's wrath is seen in Him giving people over to sin more and more
  - Sin is destructive and terrible for the person...
  - One of the worst things that could happen to a sinner...
    - Is that God would allow them to have their way...
  - The current rampant growth of sin is an indication of the wrath of God
- 3) In Death
  - Death was given as a punishment for all people when Adam sinned...
  - Paul describes it in Romans 5 as a transgression resulting in condemnation...
  - We all know of death everyday... it will happen close to us
  - Then one day we too will experience it...
  - Death is a current expression of the wrath of God
- 4) In Nature
  - The destructive forces of nature in: Tornadoes, earthquakes, volcanoes, tsunamis, Hurricanes, wildfires, thunderstorms, droughts, floods,
    - The earth has been subjected to futility
- 5) In History

- The rising and fall of civilizations and empires and people groups and individuals...
  - Notice how a group of people are destroyed when they do not honor God...
- 6) In the Cross
  - God's wrath is poured out on His Son for the sins of those who would follow Him
  - The cross was a great display of what seems to be opposing thoughts...
    - The wrath of God being poured out
    - The kindness and mercy of God being poured out...
- 7) In the Future
  - One Day there will be a final and more clear revealing of the wrath of God...
    - One day the books will be opened...
    - Revelation 20:11,12,15<sup>11</sup> Then I saw a great white throne and him who was seated on it. From his presence earth and sky fled away, and no place was found for them. <sup>12</sup> And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened... <sup>15</sup> And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.
- These are all signs that point us to one very important fact...
  - God is angry with sin... and we should flee from it...
  - God's Current Revealing of Wrath is Proof and Warning of Future Wrath
- > There is a connection between God's righteousness and God's Wrath...
  - As you notice how God's wrath has been, is currently and will one day be revealed...
    - You see God's righteousness causes Him to be a God filled with Wrath...
      - Because men are ungodly, unrighteous suppressors of truth
    - You will also notice that it is God's righteousness that also satisfies His wrath...
      - The righteousness of God is revealed in the Gospel...
      - The perfect righteous Jesus Christ would be offered up to God the Father
        - > As an appeasement of His wrath against all sinful men...
          - Who would believe in Him...

#### \* God's Wrath Satisfied in the Gospel...

- Let's go back to verses 16 and 17
  - Because... you may be very concerned right now...
  - But, back a few verses... God wants us to remember what He has done for us...
- Romans 1:16-17 <sup>16</sup> For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. <sup>17</sup> For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith for faith, as it is written, "The righteous shall live by faith."
  - To everyone who believes... (continues believing the gospel)
  - They will be given salvation from the wrath of God...
- > There is an escape from the wrath of God that is being revealed...
  - repeat

### • Our Response:

- > Fear God and Tremble Before His Wrath
  - Matt 10:28 And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather fear him who can destroy both soul and body in hell
- Believe the Gospel
- > You have two Choices before You: You are King, or God is King
- > To Believers...
  - Live in such a way as to bring glory and honor to God in all you do
  - Because GOD will discipline His children... and it is never any fun...
